



CHAMPAGNE CHÂTEAU DE BLIGNY

Blanc de Blancs Brut

Wine Description:

Situated in the heart of the Côte des Bars (Aube region) and built by the Marquis de Dampierre in the 15th Century, Château de Bligny is the only Château to benefit from the title of Château in the Champagne Region as a Grower Producer. A unique estate with an unprecedented heritage of history and winemaking. 30 hectares of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, among 8 plots, draw the Estate where all the elaboration has to take place.

Tasting Note:

A pale, beautifully fizzy golden robe. A dense, slightly mushroom-flavored nose, crystallised lemon, banana cream, nougatine, almond. A wonderfully invigorating structure, very lively and yet dense at the same time. Notes of fruit drops
