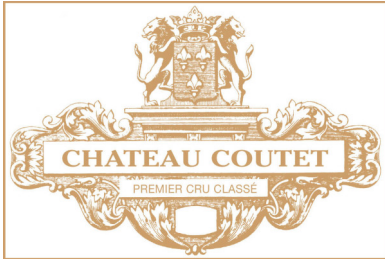
Tasting Note:

The nose blackberries, black currants, cherries, mushrooms and minerals.

The palate full bodied with silky tannins and a long plum finish.

Aroma of ripe blackberries and cherries with that well rounded meadow berry freshness on the nose that we come to expect.

The palate of slight damp earthiness and tobacco intermingled with crackled cocoa beans.
