



Single Vineyards 8 Grapes

- Varieties: Grape Cabernet Sauvignon (36%), Grenache (20%), Carignan (13%), Petit Syrah (13%), Malbec (8%), Mouvedre (5%), Carmenere (3%), Petit Verdot (2%)
- Type: Red
- Region: Aconcagua Valley, Chile
- Alcohol Level: 14.0%
- RS: 3.50 g/L
- pH: 3.55
- TA: 5.70 g/L

Wine Description:

Vineyard origin: El Encanto Estate, San Felipe.

Soil: Mountain piedmont. Coluvial soil, mixed of clay and high percentage of stone with high level of minerals.

Climate: Temperate. Luminous and warm days, cools nights during summer. High thermal amplitude.

Ageing process: 100% in French oak barrels during 16 months and 1 month in stainless steel tanks.

Tasting Note:

This red blend presents a deep ruby red color with violet hues. Its complex nose, displays aromas of red fruits, like plum and berries with well-incorporated hints of licorice and mocka. On the mouth, it presents good concentration and volume. This wine is elegant and round, with soft and silky tannins and a persistent finish. Enjoy it with all kinds of red meats and mature cheeses.
